Note: All citations should be double spaced and have a hanging indent in a Reference List. A "hanging indent" means that each subsequent line after the first line of your citation should be indented by 0.5 inches. Your reference list should be ordered alphabetically by author and then chronologically by year of publication. APA Style uses parenthetical, author-date citations. After a quote, add parentheses containing the author's name, the year of publication, and the page number of the work. For quotations that are on one page, type "p." before the page number, and for quotations that start on one page and end on another page, use "pp." as in the examples below.
