6th ed. APA In-Text Citation Examples What is an in-text citation? An in-text citation is found in the body of a research paper. It tells your reader where you found any information or ideas that are not your own. It is a shortened citation in parentheses and includes the author's last name, publication year, and the page number (if quoting).

Example: American Psychological Association. (2010). Publication manual of the American Psychological Association (6th ed.). Washington, D.C.: Author. Explanation: This includes a name of a study group, government

agency, association, corporation, etc. Put the name of the group author in the author position followed by a period.

Tips: When citing sources that you find on the Internet you only need to include a retrieval date if the information you viewed is likely to change over time (p. 192). If you reference an article from Wikipedia, for example, you would want to include a retrieval date because such information can be subject to a lot of change.

If you cite a particular post, you must cite it in the References page; you can follow the example and guidelines below. Include the author name as written (name or an organization). You do not need to include the time, simply the day and year.
