The North Carolina End-of-Course Tests are used to sample a student’s knowledge of subject-related concepts as specified in the North Carolina Standard Course of Study and to provide a global estimate of the student’s mastery of the material in a particular content area.

The North Carolina tests being waived include end-of-grade (EOG) tests in reading and math for grade levels 3 through 8, science tests in grades 5 and 8 and end-of-course (EOC) tests in Math 1 and 3, biology and English 2.
