The Code of Maryland Regulation 15.14.01.12-1(G) requiring a veterinarian to have examined a patient at least once during the 12-month period before renewing any prescription medication for a chronic condition, and prohibiting renewal of a prescription without a physical examination conducted in the previous 12-months has been modified to 18 months.
